Course of fire

The competition will consist of three matches (One Precision & Two Rapid). Number of rounds required, 30. Targets will include one precision target and two black outline targets. Whole competition will be shot at 200m.

Match 1: Precision (10 rounds)

Targets and scoring Precision target. Total match score 100 (10x)?
Practice 10 shots precision prone or foxholes, rests allowed. Time: 10min?

Match 2: Rapid (10 rounds)

Targets and scoring Large Outline Target. Total match score 100?
Practice 10 shots prone in 90 seconds. Start max 5 loaded, time to include all reloading. Competitors may use sling or free hand only. No rests allowed.

Match 3: Rapid (10 rounds)

Targets and Scoring Small Outline Target. Total match score 100?
Practice 10 shots prone in 150 seconds. Start max 5 loaded, time to include all reloading. Competitors may use sling or free hand only. No rests allowed.

Notes:

1. Rests are allowed in Match 1 only. Slings may be used for Match 2 & 3
2. All members are welcome to take part. Probationary members may shoot under supervision. Special provision for disabled (disability shooters) will be made (this does not apply to those who merely find it uncomfortable to kneel or go prone).
3. Scoring : Inward scoring. A shot hole, the lead edge of which comes in contact with the outside of the bullseye or scoring rings of a target is given the higher value. A scoring overlay gauge will be used to determine the value of close shots. The higher value will be allowed in those cases where the flange on the gauge touches the scoring ring.
4. In case of keyhole or tipped shots the higher value is awarded if the lead edge of the bullet hole touches the scoring ring of higher value even though the hole is elongated to the bullet's length rather than being a circle of the bullet's diameter.
5. Visible hits and close groups. As a general rule only those hits which are visible will be scored. An exception will be made in the case where the groupings of **3 or more shots** are so close that it is possible for a shot or shots to have gone through the enlarged hole without leaving a mark and there has been no evidence that a shot or shots have gone elsewhere than through the assigned target. In such a case, the shooter will be given the benefit of the doubt and scored hits for the non-visible shots, on the assumption they passed through the enlarged hole. If such assumption should place a non-visible hit in either of 2 scoring rings, it shall be scored in the higher-valued ring.
6. Sign in 10:00am, Competitors Briefing 10:20am.
7. Cost £7-00 (this is the lane fee only – no additional competition fee is payable).
